## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN AGRECY

- BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that in order to secure the necessary services required for the remainder of the Fiscal Year ending June 30, 1982, there is hereby authorized and appropriated from tribal funds on deposit in an Individual Indian Money account with the Fort Apache Indian Agency the sum of Mineteen Thousand Right Hundred Sixty Dollars (\$19,860,00) to be used for the following listed purposes.
  - 1. Section III (a) of TR-SiglS estimated the salary of each of two part-time Associate Judges to be \$50.00 per month or a total of \$1200.00 for the Piscal Year. This is new found not to be enough and \$200.00 of the above appropriation is hereby authorized to be used for Associate Judge's salaries.
  - 2. Section III (b) of TR 51-15 estimated that the Tribal Police Court, Jail Expenses, Pelicemen's mlatics and expenses, and Police Car Expenses would be \$24,020.00 for the Fiscal Year. This amount is now found not to be enough and \$6,000.00 of the above appropriation is hereby authorised to be used for the above listed expenses.
  - S. Section IV (a) of TR 51-15 estimated that Tribal Relief furnished those members of the Tribe net eligible for State or Federal funds would be \$40,000.00 for the Fiscal Year. This is now found to be not enough and \$15,150.00 of the above appropriation is hereby authorised to be used for Tribal Relief.
  - 4. Section VI (e) of TR 51-15 estimated that the expenses of the Predatory Anismi Trapper would be \$500.00 for the Fiscal Year. This amount is new found to be not enough and \$510.00 of the above appropriation is hereby authorised to be used for this Trapper's expenses.

The foregoing Resolution was on March 24, 1952 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (d) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
