## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

Resolution No. 52-7 adopted by the Council on March 2h,
1952 be amended as follows:

Resident fishing permits shall be available to
any person who has been a resident of the reservation for at least three menths prior to date
of application. The cost of these permits shall
be five dellars (\$5.00) per year or any part
thereof. The provision of Resolution No. 52-7
authorizing sale of these permits on a menthly
basis is hereby rescinded.
All other provisions of Resolution No. 52-7 remain
in full force and effect.

The foregoing Resolution was on April 14, 1952 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (p) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of Jame 18, 1934 (48 State 984).
