

**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

WHEREAS, there is need for additional funds for forest fire pre-suppression due to the unusual damage to roads and trails by winter storms.

BE IT RESOLVED that Resolution No. 51-15 adopted May 14, 1951, be amended to provide an additional sum of five thousand dollars (\$5,000) under Section V of the tribal budget for this purpose from available balances on hand in the Individual Indian Account of the tribe.

The foregoing Resolution was on May 5, 1952 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section (d) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
