

**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

WHEREAS, on April 3, 1951 this council approved in Resolution No. 51-12 the assignment application of the J. H. Kruse Lumber Company of Phoenix, Arizona to take over the Lost Tank Canyon Timber Unit contract from Pat Grumell and,

WHEREAS, on May 8, 1952 the Area Director did approve said assignment and he recommended that the council relieve the Kruse Lumber Company from making a special advance deposit of Three Thousand Four Hundred ten Dollars and Eighteen Cents (\$3410.18) which would make up for the deficiency in the cutting schedule of Pat Grumell.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the J. H. Kruse Lumber Company be relieved of making the special advance deposit as recommended.

The foregoing Resolution was on May 16, 1952 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (c) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 904).
