

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the remaining balance of the fund set up on Tribal Resolution 80-21 for the purpose of construction of a basketball court at Cedar Creek shall now be used for the construction of rodeo corrals, chutes and laneways at Cedar Creek. The remaining balance is \$1,982.57.

The foregoing resolution was on August 4, 1962, duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1(d) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1958 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 16, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
