

RESOLUTION OF THE  
 WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
 FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the application of the Apache Asbestos Mines, Inc. to amend its present lease, Contract I-30-Ind-2578, to include an additional five claims of approximately 20 acres each lying adjacent thereto, said claims being those formerly under lease to Charles Ireland and Gladys Eaker Bacon is hereby approved without advertising. The Chairman of the Council is authorized to sign the Amendment on behalf of the Tribal Council.

The foregoing Resolution was on September 9, 1952 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (c) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 16, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
