

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Contractors, Petersen and Osborne of the Highway 73 Right-of Way Timber Unit have applied for a time extension for the completion of this unit from September 30, 1952 to September 30, 1953, and

WHEREAS, the State Highway Department has begun no construction as planned for this summer, the logging of Petersen and Osborne is well advanced, having removed 610,000 B.F. of the 700,000 B.F. advertised,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that this extension be granted provided surety consent is obtained.

The foregoing Resolution was on September 9, 1952 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (n) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 16, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
