

**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

WHEREAS, the Arizona State Highway Department has built a good access road from the highway to the Carrise Stockman's station in order to remove sand and gravel from the riverbed, and

WHEREAS, additional repairs were discovered to be needed after starting work on the Apache Springs Stock Station under authority of Tribal Resolution No. TR 52-19,

NOW BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the sum of one thousand dollars (\$1000.00) approved under TR 52-19 to be used for Road Repair and Improvement to the Carrise Stockman's Quarters is now hereby transferred and approved to be used to complete the repairs to the Apache Springs Stock Station.

The foregoing Resolution was on September 24, 1952 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (d) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
