

**RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the sum of two thousand five hundred dollars (\$2500.00) of Tribal Funds now on deposit in an Individual Money Account at the Fort Apache Indian Agency is hereby appropriated and authorized to be paid to Mr. Bert Coulter of Springerville, Arizona for the purchase and clear title to all the cabins and any other range improvements made by him while he held a grazing permit on Tract 13-1 and which is now cancelled.

The foregoing Resolution was on September 24, 1952 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section (d) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
