RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe desires to encourage and assist in the vocational training of the young people of the Tribe,

BE IT RESOLVED that not to exceed twenty head of cows and heifers from the Tribal herd be issued to the Agricultural Club of the Theodore Roosevelt Boarding School on a repayment-in-kind basis on a contract to be approved by the Chairman of the Tribal Council and the Superintendent of the Agency.

The foregoing Resolution was on September 30, 1952 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (n) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
