

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, a mining lease to Eugene Ethelbah was authorized by Tribal Resolution No. 52-37 on September 24, 1952 and

WHEREAS, the lessee now desires to assign one-half of his interest of this asbestos mining lease to Bruce Swarthout.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache tribe that approval is hereby granted for the assignment of one-half interest of this lease issued to Eugene Ethelbah to Bruce Swarthout.

The foregoing Resolution was on November 3, 1952 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (c) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
