

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, on May 28, 1951 the Area Forester acting for and in behalf of the Area Director approved the grazing permit of the Paradise Sheep Company on Contract No. I-30-Ind-2612 covering Range No. 10, which permit is for the period May 1, 1951 to April 30, 1954 and

WHEREAS, members of the tribe have declared their need for additional range for their own livestock industry,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe in session this 3rd day of November 1952 that the termination clause of 30 days notice be hereby invoked as specified in the permit thereby terminating this contract upon the concurrence of the Area Director.

The foregoing Resolution was on November 3, 1952 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (c) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
