

Resolution of the  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe desires to encourage and assist the Reservation Medical Officer in his Health thru cleanliness program,

BE IT RESOLVED that not to exceed five hundred dollars (\$500.00) of Tribal Monies on deposit with the Treasurer of the United States be set aside for prizes and other incidental expenses in the program of cleaning up the homes on the reservation.

The foregoing resolution was on December 12, 1952 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (e) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1939, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 94).
