

WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE

A Sovereign Tribal Nation

(Authorizing Sale of Assigned Tribal Vehicles to Outgoing Council Members)

The Constitution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe ("Tribe") of the Fort Apache Indian WHEREAS, Reservation ("Reservation") provides, at Article IV, Section 1(h) that the Tribal Council ("Council") shall exercise the power "[t]o regulate the uses and disposition of Tribal property"; and

WHEREAS. Members of the Council were assigned Tribally-owned vehicles to avoid incurring unreasonable and expensive wear and tear on their personal vehicles while engaged in the duties of their office; and

At the conclusion of their Council terms, those assigned vehicles often incur high mileages and WHEREAS, are often of negligible resell value to the Tribe; and

WHEREAS, The Council finds it appropriate at this time to give the outgoing Council members, with vehicles. the option to purchase their assigned vehicles at a negligible price agreed upon by the Council.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby offers the current four outgoing Tribal Council members, with assigned vehicles, the option to purchase their assigned Tribal vehicles, in the amount of \$100.00, as agreed upon by the Council.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that in the event this Resolution directly conflicts with the Tribal Constitution, Tribal Ordinances, or any material facts concerning the issues presented are later found to be false, this Resolution shall be deemed null and void and have no legal effect.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that in the event that this Resolution conflicts with a prior Resolution or Policy, this Resolution shall supersede and govern over the conflicting subject matter.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman, or in his absence, the Vice-Chairman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

> The foregoing resolution was on APRIL 23, 2024 duly adopted by a vote of SIX for, ZERO against, and FOUR abstentions by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it under the enumerated powers listed in Article IV, Section 1, of the WMAT Constitution, so ratified on November 10, 2021, and federally recognized pursuant to Section 16 of the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
